

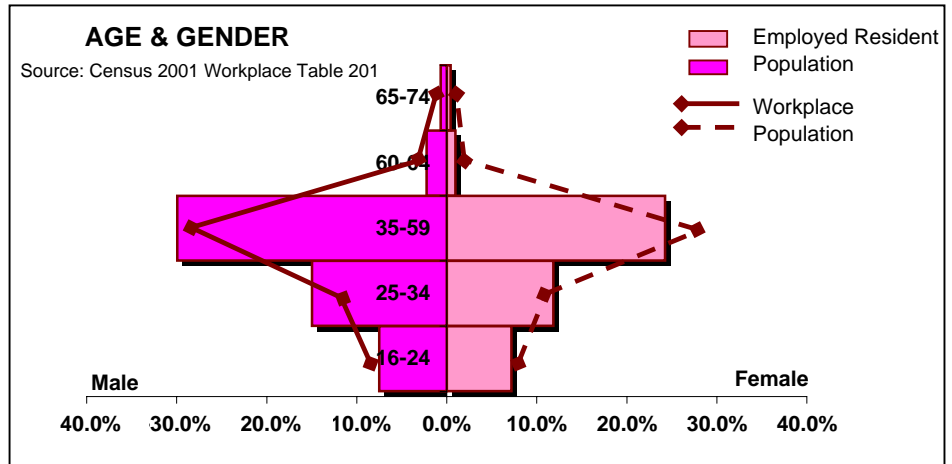

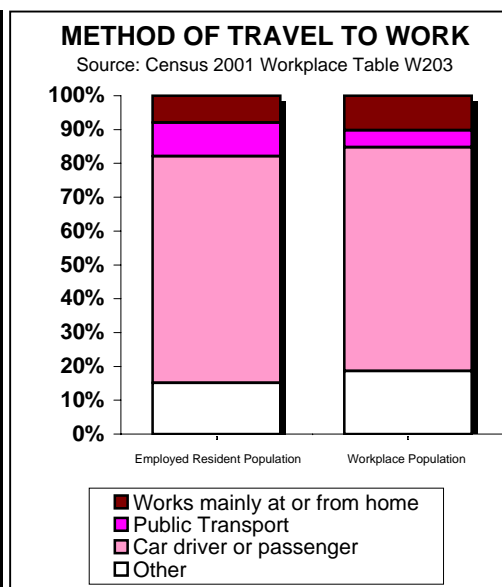

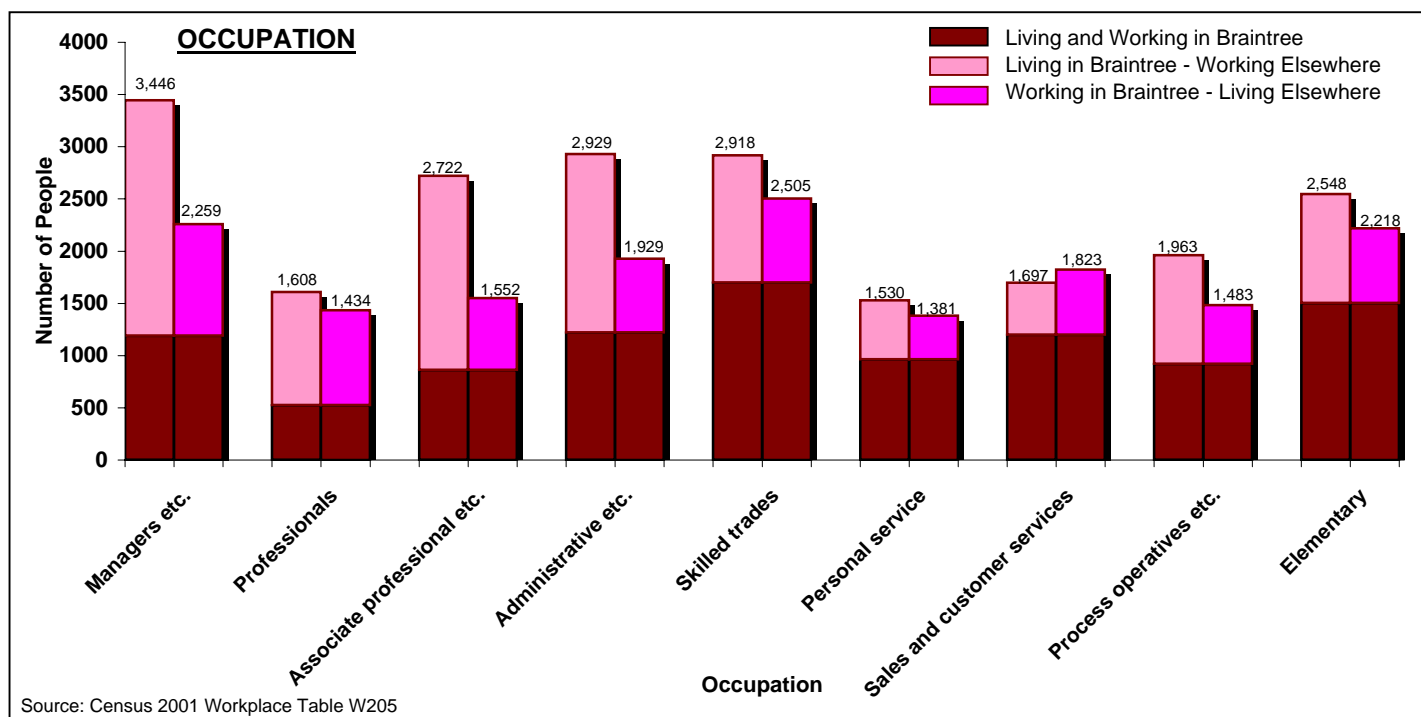

**Wards:** Bocking Blackwater, Bocking North, Bocking South, Braintree Central, Braintree East, Braintree South and Great Notley and Braintree West wards (Braintree, Essex).

**The Employed Resident Population:** All people aged 16-74 in employment who are usually resident in the area. 'Employed' includes any person who did paid work in the week before the Census, whether as an employee or self-employed. It does not include all students, only those that worked full time or part time in the week before the Census.

**The Workplace Population:** All people aged 16-74 who are in employment and whose usual place of work is in the area. People with no fixed place of work are treated the same as people who work mainly at or from home and are counted as working in their area of residence.

**Method of Travel to Work, 'Other' Category:** This includes those people travelling by taxi, motorcycle and other modes of transport.

**Confidentiality:** In order to protect the confidentiality of respondents, small random changes were made to the information collected. Some information was 'swapped' between areas or respondents, and very small numbers were rounded to the nearest 3. This means employed residents and workers totals may differ slightly between different tables.
